On May 15, 2013, the court ordered respondent Paul Hansmeier's application for admission to the bar of the Ninth Circuit held in abeyance pending possible attorney discipline proceedings in other jurisdictions. Hansmeier was directed to file a status report within 60 days, and to continue submitting status reports every sixty days. The order warned that failure to file a timely status report would be construed as a withdrawal of the application for admission to the bar of the Ninth Circuit.

Hansmeier filed regular status reports for the next two years, but he has not filed one since September 22, 2015. The court is informed that the Minnesota Lawyers Professional Responsibility Board filed a formal petition for disciplinary action on October 28, 2015, and that disciplinary proceedings remain pending.

The court construes Hansmeier's failure to file status reports apprising the court of these significant developments as a withdrawal of his application for admission to the bar of the Ninth Circuit.
